

Minutes of Sayler Park Village Council Meeting
January 4, 2017

Our president, Jackie Apted, called the meeting to order at 7:34pm. There were 20 people in attendance. We began with the pledge to the flag.

President: Jackie Apted reported. The executive board met on January 3rd, 2017 to discuss the NSP proposals submitted to the Village Council. Tonight the board will give their recommendation on how to move forward.

Vice President: Garrett Gerrard reported. There are \$7,700 is NSP funds to allocate for 2017. All funds must be used by September 2017 and receipts submitted to the Village Council. The eligibility for the funds have been outlined by the City of Cincinnati's Neighborhood Support Program.

Neighborhood Support Program Proposals (NSP): Jackie Apted reported.

1. Anthony Anneken: purchase, build, and install 4 cedar wood swings in the Nelson Sayler Park at a cost of \$2,500
2. Howard Hughes: create an Oktoberfest event at Nelson Sayler Park at a cost of \$7,420 with an estimated revenue of \$3,682
3. Mike Oberst: build 16 raised beds, a picnic table, swingset improvements, and a child reading tipi at Paper Street Farm at a cost of \$1,500
4. Jackie Apted: acquire live music acts for the Sayler Park Farmer's Market once a month from June-September at a cost of \$600
5. Mary Dornette: to fund the Duke Energy electricity fees and light bulbs around Sayler Park signs and statues at a cost of \$1,800
6. Mary Dornette: to fund the Sayler Park Farmer's Market and Harvest Festival insurance fees at the cost of \$1,100
7. Sienna Condy: to create a new Sayler Park Community website and to provide digital and print copies of a newsletter that will be distributed to residents at a cost of \$2,200
8. Tom Wells: to purchase mulch, flowers, soil etc for the beautification of Sayler Park at a cost of \$2,000

The recommendation of the Sayler Park Village Council's Executive Board is to use the NSP funds for items #4, #5, #6, #7, and #8 above at a total cost of \$7,700.

A vote was taken regarding the recommendation of the Village Council, 18 votes for the recommended proposals, 0 against. The proposals will be submitted to the City of Cincinnati by January 9, 2017.
